



Class Warfare: Driving Towards College Admissions in Top-Tier U.S. Secondary Schools

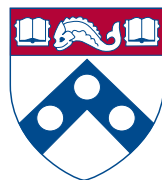
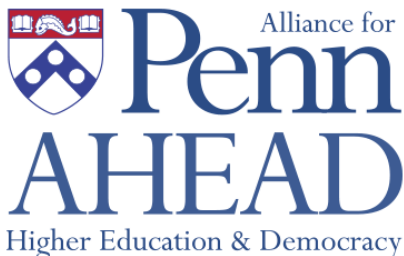
Featured Speaker: Dr. Lois Weis
