Direct Service Program Components

Services for high school students include:

- long-term, one-to-one mentoring
- Financial incentives
- Intensive, personalized, college guidance, placement and retention services
- Year-round academic enrichment
- Gender specific programming
- Clubs and activities
- Staff support

Services to collegians include:

- Individualized academic and personal support and counseling
- Financial support including \$6,000 to help with college-

related expenses

- Graduate school preparation
- Career counseling
- Paid internships

- 98% of our students have matriculated into college.
- Our college graduation rate is now averaging between 60% and 70%.
