Applied Research and Policy

This course examines the links between education and socio-economic development in Africa and presents some of the theories and empirical methodologies used to inform education and development policies. It is designed to review empirical evidence on the relationship between education and development and introduce various research designs and data analysis techniques employed by researchers to provide policy-makers with reliable and verifiable information. Discussions will consider major shifts in the way this relationship has been perceived by development theorists and economists during the past 50 years but contemporary global consultations that will shape education/development agendas in African countries in the post-2015 era will also be explored.





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
