IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ

- 1. To fully cover your tuition, you will need to request 2 loans:
 - a. One \$20,500 Unsubsidized Direct Loan that spans 2017 summer semester 2018 spring semester.
 - b. A \$45,700 GradPLUS loan or private loan that spans 2017 July 2018 May to cover the remaining balance. Be sure to include the <u>origination fee</u> if requesting a GradPLUS loan. Reduce the GradPLUS/ private loan by any amount you intend to have covered through personal resources, scholarships, employer benefits; etc.
- 2. You are not eligible for federal loans in the final summer semester. However, you will receive a refund in the fall and spring from which you will need to reserve at least \$6,600 to cover the summer 2018 semester.
- 3. Your actual refund will be the difference between your total loan disbursements per semester and charges (tuition & fees). The maximum refund you can receive in the summer is \$8,300, and in the fall and spring semester it is \$14,405 per semester.
 - a. Refund = Total Loan Disbursement Total Tuition & Fees
 - b. Refund = max \$8,300 in Summer, max \$14,405 in fall and spring semesters each
- 4. If you need additional money for living expenses, when completing the loan request form, select the option that allows the school to process your GradPLUS loan for maximum eligibility.
- 5. Tuition and fees do not include travel expenses for Ed Ent. weekends and intensives.

^{**}The final summer semester tuition may be subject to a 2-5% increase from previous semesters' tuition rates as it takes place in a new fiscal year.
